
Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Eight hundred Dollars to me paid by Thomas McCoy in the State aforesaid and of Greenville District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas McCoy all that piece parcel & tract of Land situate in the District of Greenville Lying near the Pendleton Road upon Drushy creek and bounded as follows beginning at a red oak 37 and running thence South 18 E 30 chains 50 L to a stake thence N 85 W 10 chains 28 L to a stake thence N 18 W 30 chains to a stake thence South 84 1/2 E 10 chains to the beginning corner, the same being represented by a copy plat accompanying the deed of W H Mauldin Executor of Est of Jobab Mauldin decd made to me on the 22 day of February 1861 and containing thirty acres be the same more or less

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas McCoy his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas McCoy his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three and in the words twenty seven acres, also, three acres stricken out before signing"
