parcel and tract of land containing Two hundred and twenty acres more or less situate lying and being on Needy River and Langston's Branch and on the south side of the Buncombe road about three miles from Greenville Court House in the District and State aforesaid adjoining lands of J W Brooks & S Irvine No 73 Earle and H P Hammett and having the following lines metes and bounds, Viz, beginning at the Bridge over Langston Branch on the Buncombe road and running thence down the ditch to Needy River, thence down Needy River to a Beech 340 thence N 31 1/2 E to the Buncombe Road and thence with said road to the beginning corner being a portion of the tract of land conveyed to me by J W Brooks by Deed of 26th April 1869 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold ~~the~~ and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Bates his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Bates his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person who may hereafter lawfully claim or to claim the same or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal this Twenty eighth day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty three and in the 3rd year of the Independence of the Confederate States of America
