L. Thomas of the District & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said William L. Thomas all that piece parcel & tract of land known as the Joel Charles plantation on Grove Creek about ten miles from Greenville S. C. & containing about two thousand and forty three and one half acres & having the following lines metes & bounds, viz, beginning at a large black oak near the ten mile post on the Grove road adjoining the lands of W. A. Pepper & James Charles thence N 45 W 62.28 along the line of James Charles to the center of a ditch by a stone on the Grove Creek thence up said Creek 7.65 to the mouth of Rice's Spring branch by a stone thence along the line of James Charles & Miss Nancy Brock up Rice Spring branch about 49.09 to a stone thence N 10 1/2 W 2.08 to a stone dogwood stump thence N 80 1/2 E 24.87 to a stake persimmon gum thence
