Know all men by these presents
 that I Thomas Smith of the State and District aforesaid
 in consideration of the respect and friendship I have and
 bear to my friend Henrietta Shockely and also in considera-
 -tion of the sum of Ten Dollars to me in hand paid by the
 said Henrietta Shockely the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 -ged have bargained sold and conveyed and assigned and by
 these presents do bargain sell convey and assign at my death
 unto the said Henrietta Shockely and her heirs all of my
 notes money and acpts and effects of what soever I may be
 possessed of at my death to have and to hold forever and I
 do hereby give full power and authority unto the said Henrietta
 Shockely or her heirs to demand sue for and recover all my
 notes and acpts as their own right and property. The condi-
 -tions of the above assignment and transfer is such that the said
 Henrietta Shockely is to keep and maintain me as one
 of her family during my natural life and after my death
 the said notes money and all my acpts are to belong
 to the said Henrietta Shockely absolutely in her own right
