 that I Thomas Smith of the State and District aforesaid  
 in consideration of the respects and friendship I have and  
 bear to my friend Henrietta Shockley and also in considera-  
 tion of the sum of Ten Dollars to me in hand paid by the  
 said Henrietta Shockley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
 ged and have bargained sold and conveyed and assigned and by  
 these presents do bargain sell convey and assign at my death  
 unto the said Henrietta Shockley and her heirs all of my  
 notes money and effects and affects of what soever I may be  
 possessed of at my death to have and to hold forever and I  
 do hereby give full power and authority unto the said Henrietta  
 Shockley or her heirs to demand sue for and recover all my  
 notes and effects as their own right and property. The condic-  
 -ons of the above assignment and transfer is such that the said  
 Henrietta Shockley is to keep and maintain me as one  
 of her family during my natural life and after my death  
 the said Notes money and all my effects are to belong  
 to the said Henrietta Shockley absolutely in her own *etc*
