F & C Keahn To Francis Keahn Trust	Deed of Trust	The State of South Carolina This Indenture Tripartite made on this the sixteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three between Francis Keahn of the first part Charles Keahn of the second part and Francis Keahn as Trustee for Mrs Mary Keahn of the third part, Witnesseth that whereas the said parties of the first and second part are seized and possessed as joint tenants of a certain Lot or parcel of Land situate lying and being in Green ville Village on Spring Brown and Coffee Streets fronting on Coffee Street two hundred and thirteen feet and on Spring and Brown Street one hundred and thirty feet each, and whereas it is desired that the said land should be divided and set apart so that each party may enjoy and hold his own in severally free and disincumbered from any inconvenience of joint tenancy and both parties being of legal age to consent to said division they the said parties of the first and second part have come to the understanding covenant and agreement hereinafter set forth. And whereas the said Charles or Christian Keahn is anxious and desirous to provide a home for his beloved wife who is a stranger in the land when she lives and mindful of the many uncertainties which attend a revolution such as his adopted country is now enduring, and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar paid to him by the party of the third part the said party of second part has given granted decided aliened and released unto the party of the third part all his right title interest and portion which he has in and to the aforementioned lot of land and authorizes the aforementioned party of the first part to make to the said party of the third part good and sufficient titles thence in the partition and division hereinafter mentioned. So that the said party of the third part may hold the same in trust for the aforesaid Mrs Mary Keahn during her natural life allowing her to
