 A Mitchell Land that I L Westmoreland of the State
 aforesaid & district of Greenville for

& in consideration of Seventy six dollars to me in hand paid by Archibald Mitchel of the same State & district have granted bargained sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Archibald his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing nineteen acres more or less situate in Greenville District State aforesaid being a part of the grant made to Robert Miller the 4th of December 1786 on both sides of Madams Branch beginning at a white oak small 3^t on J L Westmoreland corner near Madams branch & on a small branch J L Childers line running S 43 W 41 16 30 to a peachtree stump thence S 40 1/2 E 65 links to poplar 3^t new on the bank of Madams branch thence up the meanders of said branch about 16.20 to a stake in the fork of said branch thence S 53 E 15.15 to a stone corner of A Mitchells land thence N 7 1/2 W 41.25 to the beginning, together with all & singular the rights, members hereditaments & appartenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all & singular the said premises unto the said Archibald Mitchel his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Archibald Mitchel his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
