of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, but at present of the Confederate States Army, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Dollars to me paid by Joseph Glover of Colleton District in the State aforesaid Trustee under and by virtue of the Deed of Marriage Settlement, dated 18th May A.D. 1842 between A H Jenkins of the first part Miss Margaret Glover of the second part and George A French and Claudian B Northrop of the third part which is recorded in Marriage Settlement Book No 15 pages 207 to 223, in the office of the Secretary of State at Charleston in the State aforesaid, the said Joseph Glover having been substituted for said George A French and Claudian B Northrop according to the limitations and terms of said Deed of Marriage Settlement by the appointment in writing, before two witnesses made by the said A H Jenkins, and Margaret Jenkins formerly Margaret Glover, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Glover Trustee as aforesaid all that lot or parcel of land lying, situate, and being in the Town of Greenville in the District of Greenville in the State of South Carolina on Bancombe Street adjoining lands of L M Hatch & Mcbee & A Hamid containing two acres more or less, and more particularly described in a mortgage-deed by me made to Spartan H Goodlett and Henry R Williams on record in the office in the office of Record of Meine Conveyance for Greenville District at Greenville
