Know all men by these presents that we Humphry H Parish and J Walker Parish of State & District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James McManis of State & District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James McManis a certain tract or parcel of land lying in State & District aforesaid on both sides of Greens Creek waters of South Paulet River adjoining lands of Reuben Bowden Thomas Reed John B Place Nile Butler & others beginning at a white oak Bowden Reeds corner and running N 28 W 32.00 to stake in old creek run thence N 15 W 7.00 to a Post oak, thence N 5 E 8.00 to a Post oak thence N 31 1/2 W 8.50 to chestnut thence N 45 W 7.55 to Pine, thence N 66 W 82.00 to a stake, thence N 27 1/2 W 12.60 to Large Poplar, thence S 17 1/2 W 32.26 to a Hickory thence S 45 E 25.00 to chestnut, thence S 22 W 15.00 to White oak thence S 20 W 15.50 to double chestnut, thence N 62 E 29.60 to White oak stump thence S 88 E 30.50 to Black oak thence South 13.00 to stake in field, thence S 48 E 15.50 to chestnut, thence N 41 E 10.70 to chestnut on ledge thence N 84 1/2 E 37.10 to the beginning corner containing six thousand and forty four acres more or less.
