 Henry Barton et als for the partition of the Real Estate of Alfred
 Cantrell deceased, And the cause being at issue before the
 Honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers Term in
 the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Sixty three
 when the said Court after full hearing and mature deliberation
 in the premises did order adjudge and decree that said Real
 estate should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner
 of the said court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned
 in their several Orders as by reference thereto in the registry of the

 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said John H Goodwin and his heirs
