 to me paid by William Bates Thomas Mc Coy and Henry P. Ham  
 mett of the said District and State being and composing the  
 firm of William Bates & Co Ham granted bargained sold and  
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said William Bates Thomas Mc Coy and Henry P.  
 Hammett all that piece parcel and tract of land containing  
 Seventeen thousand and three and one half acres (1703 1/2)  
 more or less situated lying and being on both sides of Reedy  
 River in the District and State aforesaid adjoining lands of  
 Sam Young Hawkins Cleveland Shoetley Benson Cleveland  
 and others and having the following lines marks and bounds  
 as represented by a plat of the same made by James K. Dickson  
 L.S. for 19<sup>th</sup> November 1863 and annexed to this Deed, Viz, beginning  
 at a stake 3+3+ on the S.W. side of Reedy River and running thence S 77
