

to the said firm, from depreciation of property, bad debts
 fire or other accident or misfortune, such losses shall be
 born equally by the said partners of said firm. Tenth If
 either of the said partners shall die before the expiration of
 the said term of copartnership, all the property, business
 and assets of the said firm, shall immediately vest in and
 be held possessed and owned by the surviving partners, and
 the said surviving partners shall forthwith, fully account
 for and pay over to the legal representatives of the deceased
 partner the value in money at that time of the interest of
 the said deceased partner in the capital, property, assets
 and profits of said firm, and the interest of such deceased
 partner therein shall from thenceforth utterly cease and be
 determined. Eleventh at the end of the time of said copar-
 tnership, or at its earlier determination other than by death
 as aforesaid, the said copartners each to the other shall make
 a true just and final account of all things pertaining to
 their said business and in all things truly adjust the same
 and all and every the property, stock, assets, profits, moneys
 or other means of the said firm shall be equally divided betw-
 een the said partners. Twelfth The profits made by said
 firm after the payment of its expenses and of the allowances
 to the said Robert Greenfield and James Banister for their
 service shall be divided equally between the said John W. Grady,
 Robert Greenfield and James Banister. Thirteenth During
 the term of the said copartnership neither of the said part-
 ners shall become security or endorser for any person without
 the consent of the other partners. Fourteenth In the event
 of the violation of any portion of these articles of agreement
 by either of the said partners, the other partners or either
 of them shall have the right to declare the said partnership
 to be at an end and to demand and have an immediate
 settlement of its affairs.
