Mr Emory Trust	Lat	I Hester Blodgett of Greenville District

in the State aforesaid in consideration of One thousand dollars to me paid by William Emory Trustee for Elizabeth Emory and also her consent for the said William Emory to go to the Service of the Confederate States as Substitute for H. Blodgett of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Emory Trustee for Mrs Elizabeth Emory his wife a certain lot of land lying within or near the corporation of the Village of Greenville on the S West Side of Ruddy River and near the Greenville & Col N Road, on the South Side & bounded as follows. To wit beginning at a Stake Nays old corner on a Street and runs thence with said line S $9\frac{1}{2}$ W 5 chains 67 links to a Stake Nays upper corner thence N 89 W 2 chs 25 links to a Stake, thence N $9\frac{1}{2}$ E 5 chs 67 lks to a Street Stake corner thence along said Street S 89 E 2 chs 25 lks to the beginning corner containing one Acre & one rood more or less being the lot I purchased of Peter Cauble & A M Bee bearing date 31st August 1863. for particulars see said deed. Also with the right of the Trustee to sell & reinvest the proceeds in real estate with her consent giving him the Trustee right to make titles, Together with all and singular the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Emory Trustee for Elizabeth Emory her heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Emory Trustee for Elizabeth Emory her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
