Hoff his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against the said A. H. Jenkins and Margaret Jenkins and their heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four and in the 89th year of the sovereignty and Independence of the State of South Carolina signed sealed & delivred in the presence of Joseph Glover Trustee of A.
