Trenholm of Charleston District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George A. Trenholm all that piece parcel and tract of land containing nearly one half acre, situate lying and being in the town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and having the following limits and bounds, beginning at a stake on Hughes Street, Trenholms N & E corner, and running thence with said Street N 7 E One hundred feet to a stake of Elford's S & E corner, thence with Elford's lot N 77 W Two hundred & thirteen feet to a stake on Beatties line thence with Beatties lot S One hundred feet to a stake Trenholms N W corner, and thence with Trenholms lot N 77 E Two hundred & twenty one feet to the beginning being a portion of the land conveyed by Executor E. Craft to J. B. Sherman and by him to my self. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining I do hereby give, sell, warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George A. Trenholm his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George A. Trenholm his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
