Know all men by these presents that I Henry T.

Strand of Greenville District of the State aforesaid in consideration of One Bay mare known as the Hawkin's Mare to me paid by Joseph Mulleray of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Mulleray all my right title and interest to and in a certain tract of land or parcel of land lying and being in said District on the waters of Mesh Creek bounded by lands of James McKinney Deceased. Mr Cox & James Jackson it being part of a tract of land owned by John Miller Deceased supposed to be about thirty seven acres more or less. This instrument is intended to convey all my interest in the said premises to the said Joseph Mulleray his heirs and assigns forever. Together with all and singular all my right title and claim to the premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the same against myself my heirs and assigns forever. Witness my hand and seal this the 10th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and sixty four and in the 4th year of the Independence of the State of South Carolina.
