

James Gosnell	Deed	South Carolina	Know all men by these presents that I James Gosnell of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Mary Gosnell of the same State and District the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained sold released and conveyed and by these presents do give grant bargain sell release and convey unto the said Mary Gosnell a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the State and District above named on the North Side of the Link hole Fork of Tyger river and bounded as follows viz beginning on a stone corner on the original line and was originally a Post oak on the original line thence North 45 to a white oak thence South 38 west 17 to a Black gum thence South 51 west 7 chains and 27 links to a chestnut thence South 57 west 17 to a maple thence a chestnut a straight line nearly South to the main Road ford on the Creek thence with the meanderings of said creek to the conditional line thence with the said conditional to a rock thence to the beginning corner containing forty acres more or less. To have and to hold the above granted premises together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and the said James Gosnell do hereby bind my self my heirs executors administrators and assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted premises against myself my heirs and assigns and against any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of March one thousand eight hundred and sixty five Signed sealed and delivred in presence of James Gosnell Seal of William Barton B E Chastain
