Five mules viz one Black horse mule (one Somel mare mule, one mouse colored horse mule Two Bay horse mules; one Brown horse; one mare & Colt; 3 Wagons viz one four horse wagon; one two horse and one one horse wagon; one Jack Twelve head of cattle; One yoke of Oxen; one Barouche or Carriage; my Tan Yard, tools and stock; One Piano; Four tables One Wardrobe, Five Bedsteads & Beds Ten chairs - one lot of crockery; To have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid property in Trust for the sole use and benefit of my aforesaid wife Temperance to Kilgore during her life and at her death said property to go or descend as her father Joseph Sullivan has directed her said trust estate to be distributed in his last will and testament, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the aforesaid property unto the said W A Sullivan for the use and purposes above referred to, Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of this Twenty second day of March A D 1856
