Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Thomas Steen for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of to the said Thomas Steen by the said Ollis Miller, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ollis Miller all that Lot or parcel of land situated in the town of Greenville containing two acres more or less beginning at a stake on Hutherford Street Stone Corner and running thence E. 24. 12 poles to a stake whence S. 61. 13. poles to a stake whence W. 24. 12 poles to a stake at Hutherford street whence with said Hutherford Street N. 4. 10. 13 poles to the beginning being the same land conveyed by Croft to Goodlett, Goodlett to McDavid, McDavid to Jenkins, Jenkins to Ollis Miller. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ollis Miller his heirs and assigns forever and I do humbly bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ollis Miller his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming in to claim the same or any part thereof. Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that of the said Thomas Steen his heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Ollis Miller the sum of Eighteen Hundred dollars and interest according to the note aforesaid above mentioned. Then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum i n before set forth and the interest for the same it shall and may be lawful and for the said Thomas Steen peaceably and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and release and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding in witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals by day and year first above written 3
