Together with all the Mills, Houses, machinery, and other rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident to them and to hold the same to them and their heirs and assigns forever — And the said first party for and in consideration of these presents and the sum of three dollars to him in hand paid by the said second party the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and conveyed all their right titles and estates to the said second party in and to the Pendleton Factory and the lands connected therewith situated being, and being in Anderson District of this State on Three and Twenty Creek adjoining lands of Adair and others containing six hundred and fifty acres from Benjamin H. Sloan and Benjamin H. Sloan President of the Pendleton Manufacturing Company to John W. Grady, David O'Hawthorne and William Perry record in the office of the Recorder of Meeme County at Anderson Court House of this State. Together with all other Mills houses machinery and other rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident to them and to hold the same to him and his heirs and assigns forever subject always however first to a certain mortgage now outstanding and binding upon the said Pendleton Factory and the portion of the land purchased from Benjamin H. Sloan President of the Pendleton Manufacturing Company for thirteen thousand dollars and interest thereon from the day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six payable to the said B. H. Sloan President as aforesaid. And given by John W. Grady, David O'Hawthorne and William Perry to said Benjamin H. Sloan President as aforesaid a certain promissory note of Grady, Hawthorne & Perry to said B. H. Sloan President as aforesaid payable on or before the day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven for the above amount of thirteen thousand dollars and interest from the date of the said promissory note. And the said second party hereby covenants and agrees with the first party to assume and pay the note and mortgage to B. H. Sloan as above recited and all debts or liabilities of Grady, Hawthorne & Perry now unpaid which have been incurred in the purchase management or supply of the Pendleton Factory, also the sum of dollars found due to said first party by said second party upon an adjustment of their accounts. And it is further covenanted and agreed between and by these parties that each party respectively within forty days take up pay or assume upon themselves in their individual name or that of any copartnership which they may then after form the liabilities they herein assume, or that the sum of Grady, Hawthorne and Perry may be released therefrom excepting the above Mortgage to B. H. Sloan President which may otherwise
