The condition of the above obligation is such that if the said Francis Turner & Missouri Turner shall support and maintain the said Alfred Turner & Anna Turner his wife during their natural life time, and also to support Joseph H. Turner during the life time of the said Alfred Turner & Anna Turner and also to support Elam Turner & Narcia Turner their sisters until they have come unto the age of twenty one years. And when Elam Turner & Narcia Turner have arrived to the age of twenty one years then the said Francis Turner & Missouri Turner shall give them each a Bed and furniture and at the death of the said Alfred Turner & Anna Turner his wife shall the said Francis Turner & Missouri Turner shall sell all the property which I have deeded to them & devise the proceeds of sale equally between themselves and all their brothers and sisters so as to make them all equal with the expense paid and standing
