and sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said Mary C Spear her heirs and assigns all that lot or parcel of land  
situate lying and being in the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville on  
the west side of the Pencombe Road being the house and lot wherein Mrs  
Emily E Howland resided at the time of her death adjoining lots of Henry  
M East and others containing three acres being Lot No 2 as described in  
the pleading and in the return of the commissioners in partition of the  
estate of Mrs Emily E Howland deceased. Together with all and singular the  
hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said lot belonging
