 Lawrence Williams and know all men by these presents that
 I Ira C Williams of Anderson District
 in the State aforesaid in consideration of fourteen thousand and
 twenty dollars \$1470. To me paid by Lawrence C Williams of
 Greenville District in the State aforesaid having granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Lawrence
 C Williams all that piece parcel and tract of land containing
 one hundred and two (112) acres more or less situate
 lying and being on the Augusta road, and on the waters of
 Holden Wood Creek, and adjoining lands of R. B. Johnson
 Sarah Charles C. Farmer and James Mc Baird, in the
 District of the State aforesaid
 and having the following lines limits and bounds viz
 viz. at W. cor. N. 3. + 0. 2. and running thence N. 8 1/2 W. 100 paces
 to D. 3. thence S. 11 W. 19. 10. to a stake 3 + 0. 2. now 2000
 thence S. 48 E. 17. 00. to a stake 3 + 4. 10. thence S. 77 E. 87. 40. to a
 P. C. 111 O. Co. now 3 + 1. 10. and thence S. 10 E. 11. 30. to the beginning
 as represented by a plat annexed to this deed together with
 all and singular the rights members then due and
 appertaining unto the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining to laws and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lawrence
 C Williams his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said Lawrence C Williams his heirs and
 assigns against me and my heirs and every other person

whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty second day of
 August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty six and in the ninety first year of the Independence
 of the United States of America the words "State of South Carolina"
 being first traced and the words "Gerritt" being first
 interlined
