McConnell of said District and State, we have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William A. McConnell all that piece parcel and lot of land situated lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit on the South and North by Lots of the said William A. McConnell and the West by Main Street and on the East by a back street running parallel with Main Street being 100 feet wide and 100 feet long, and herebefore kept open as a street or alley and laid in the plan of said Town as Judge Alley, containing one-fifth of an acre more or less, together with all and singular the rights, members, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William A. McConnell his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said Wardens do hereby bind ourselves and our successors in office to warrant and defend the said William A. McConnell his heirs and assigns against all and singular persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
