

W. C. Crowbridge ^{Deed} ^{to} ^{for} ^{Land} State of South Carolina
 Greenville County
 Know all men by these presents that I William C. Crowbridge of the State of South Carolina in consideration of Twelve hundred dollars lawful money of the United States of America to me paid by Silas H. Crowbridge of the State & County aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Silas H. Crowbridge four hundred acres of Land more or less in two tracts, first known as the homestead of Henry Smith Decr containing two hundred acres more or less lying in the County & State aforesaid on the water of Little Sandy Fork of Sandy River adjoining lands of the late James Moon Thomas Hopkins & others having such Meets & bounds as are found in a Deed made by Wm. Young to Henry Smith dated 31st March 1818 being the same tract of land formerly belonging to Henry Smith Decr and conveyed to Arlene Smith by William M. Thomas Commissioner in Equity for Greenville County by Deed bearing date second day of January 1860 and conveyed to William C. Crowbridge by James P. Moon Commissioner in Equity for Greenville District now County by Deed bearing date second of August 1861 the second tract lying in the State & County aforesaid adjoining tract above described also the lands of Samuel Moon Decr & Jno. C. Sullivan Drury Hopkins Decr & others as is described in deed made to William C. Crowbridge by Wm. Thomas then Commissioner in Equity for Greenville Dist. now County it also being the tract of land conveyed and described in a deed from W. Hunt to Mordica M. Smith dated the 19th of March 1842 to which reference is her made for particulars described of the line & boundaries containing two hundred acres more or less together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Silas H. Crowbridge his heirs & assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises in two tracts as described unto the said Silas H. Crowbridge his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.  This indenture made the seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight between James P. Moon Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and James H. Thaxton of the other part Whereas John N. Green Sumner and John W. Cunningham Esqs on or about the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & sixty eight exhibited their bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Jordan P. Pool and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the Lot of Land & Living Stables therein described in the Bill shall be sold at public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear and the said James P. Moon Esq as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Lot & Stables thereon for sale by Public Auction on the first Monday of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & sixty eight did then openly and publicly and according to the Custody of Auctioneers sell and dispose of the said Lot of Land & Stables thereon below described unto the said James H. Thaxton for Five hundred and two dollars he being at that price the highest bidder for the same. Now then John Thaxton doth hereby certify that the said James P. Moon Esq as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars paid him by the said James H. Thaxton the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said James H. Thaxton the above and aforesaid all that Lot of Land and Living Stables thereon situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid within the Corporate limits of the Town of Greenville containing one half acre more or less and bounded as follows one hundred and twenty feet on Spring street on the East two hundred feet on Wakarusa Lot on the North one hundred and twenty feet on Brown street on the West being the same Lot & Stables as the old Living Stables of James H. Thaxton together with all and singular the hereditaments Rights Members and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Lot of Land & Stables thereon belonging or in anywise appertaining and the necessary and lawful Bound Remainder & other Issues and Profits thereof and also all the Claims Rights & Interests therein
