Willard Lewis as a grant from the Missionary Society of the Metho-  
dist Episcopal Church in the United States of America have granted  
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant buy  
and sell and release unto the following trustees and their success-  
ors in office viz- William Cook Ellick Maxwell Francis Williamson James  
Byrkit Charles T. Hopkins James Rosamond and the said P. Willard  
Lewis in trust that the said premises shall be used kept maintain-  
ed and disposed of as a place of Divine worship for the use of the  
Ministry and membership of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the  
United States of America subject to the discipline usage and man-  
agement and declaration of the General conference of said church and  
the annual conference in whose bounds the said premises are  
situated. A certain piece or plat of land situated and being in the  
Town of Greenville in the State of South Carolina on the East or North  
side of Reedy River on a Street running to Mrs. Charles residence  
beginning at a Stake on said Street sixty feet on the opposite side  
of said Street from the corner of the same and runs thence S 71. E.  
one hundred and fifty feet to a Stake thence S 13. W. two hundred and  
fifty feet to a Stake thence N 77. W. one hundred and fifty feet to a  
Stake thence N 13. East one hundred and fifty feet to the beginning  
corner containing by estimation two rods and one perch and some  
feet more or less being a small portion of a certain tract of land  
assigned to the Alex. McPee and V. O. McPee by order of the court

New and cut less Noleh Cow Eight heads of Hogs and one  
two horse Wagon warranted free of incumbrances and con-  
-taining any and all adverse claims to have and to hold the  
said property to the said J. M. Cottrell his Executors Admin-  
-istrators and assigns forever. Provided never the less that if  
the said Branch Vaughn his Executors pay or cause to be  
paid to said J. M. Cottrell his Executors the sum of sixty  
nine dollars and forty three cents with interest from date  
then this deed as also a certain note bearing even date her-  
-ewith given by the said Branch Vaughn to the said J. M. Cot-  
-trell to pay the said sum and interest and at the same  
time aforesaid shall both be void. And it is agreed that  
the Mortgage his executors administrators and assigns shall  
remain in possession of said property till conditions broken  
in no time whereof I the said Branch Vaughn have her-  
-eto set my hand and seal this March 7th 1870
