 Greenville containing four hundred and ninety nine acres more or
 less adjoining lands of James H Ashmun and others and known as
 the Mcken Factory tract of land the said premises containing the
 cotton and woolen mills saw and grist mills lately occupied by
 Grady & Hawthorn together with all the Machinery Spindles Looms
 and other appurtenances belonging to said Factory and mills
 Logjams with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the
 premises before mentioned unto the said Frank McKenzie his heirs
 and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors
