This Indenture entred into between J M Crotwelle
of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid of the
one part, and Ferry Lourne of the County and State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that whereas the said J M Crotwelle as aforesaid have by these presents
agreed to make advances to the said Ferry Lourne for agricultural purposes
not to exceed Fifty three hundred Dollars during the year one thousand
eight hundred and seventy now the said Ferry Lourne hereby agrees
to give unto the said J M Crotwelle as aforesaid herein for the amount which
shall be so advanced with the interest thereon at the rate of Six per centum
per annum, on all the crops of whatsoever description he may grow or
cause to be grown during the year aforesaid on the farm or
plantation of the said Henry Boons in the County and State aforesaid
in accordance with the Act of the General Assembly of the State
of South Carolina entitled An Act to secure Advances for agricultural
purposes ratified the twentieth day of September in the year of
one thousand eight hundred and sixty six, and it is
further agreed by and between the parties as aforesaid by these
presents that the said Ferry Lourne for himself his executors
administrators and assigns does hereby consent promise and
agree to and with the said J M Crotwelle as aforesaid that all the
crops of whatsoever description reaped and grown by him shall not be
removed from his said farm or plantation without the written consent
of the said J M Crotwelle as aforesaid And that if the aforesaid amount
of advances as aforesaid shall not well and truly be paid by or before
the first of December next it shall and may be lawful for the said J M Crotwelle
as aforesaid or the survivor of them if either of them shall die before that date
and at any time after the first of December next peaceably and quietly to
enter into any or all the meadows lands or tenements of the said Ferry Lourne
and to take into their custody or the custody of the survivor of them if
either should die and the same to hold and detain to their own use and
behoof so that they may sell and dispose of said crops of whatsoever descrip-
tion at their pleasure returning the same plus if any should happen to be
after paying of the above mentioned sum unto themselves the said J M
Crotwelle as aforesaid unto the said Ferry Lourne his executors admin-
istrators or assigns. In witness whereof we the said parties of the first
and second part have hereunto set our hand and seal this the 23 day
of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy
