 thousand eight hundred and sixty six executed his Bill
 of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House
 in the said State against Albert A. Hart et al and this cause
 being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard
 at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty six when the said Court after full hearing
 thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order
 adjudge and decree that a writ of Partition should issue
 to and the Commissioners return to said writ of Partition recom-
 mended which recommendation was confirmed by the Court thence

 more fully appear by that of Willis P. Thorntons P. B. made
 on 31st July 1866 and herewith attached together with all and
 singular the Hereditaments rights members and appurtenances
 whatsoever to the said tract of Land belonging or in anywise
