all of the State and County above written. Witnesseth that whereas
the Said J T D S McCullough have advanced to me monies and
supplies heretofore to enable me to make and
gather my present crops. Now for these favours of advancements
I do hereby give to the Said J T D S McCullough a first Lien on
my entire crop raised and produced on my plantation and to fully
secure them for these favours and advancements. I in addition
to this Lien bind to them any other property owned by me until
all that I may be due them is fully discharged and paid. That this
obligation is to be full and void, order to remain in force for ever
and witness when off I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this 27th day May A.D. 1870
