So I have & hold the said lot of one acre to the said Jack Thompson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant all singular the premises to the said Jack Thompson his heirs and assigns forever against me my heirs and assigns signed sealed and delivered this 21st Sep 1866 In presence of W.
