 This indenture made the 15th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy between J. P. Mc Coy and W. A. Austin of the one part and John Johnson of the other part witnesseth whereas the said J. P. Mc Coy and W. A. Austin have this day executed these joint and several notes under seal whereby the following is a copy on or by the 1st of December 1871 we or either of us promise to pay John Johnson or his five hundred and fifty dollars for Value received due the 1st 1870 with interest from 20 of December 1870 as within our hands and seals December 8th 1871

Now this indenture witnesseth that the said J. P. Mc Coy and W. A. Austin for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to the said J. P. Mc Coy and W. A. Austin by the said John Johnson in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Johnson all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on waters of Stony Creek waters of of Rudy River adjoining land of J. M. Coy Gilly Clark and others and containing one hundred and twenty seven acres more or less being the same tract land this day deeded to me by J. W. Glenn for more particular description see last deed
