This indenture made the
 fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty one between Samuel Campbell
 of the one part and William Pearson of the other part
 witnesses whereas the said William Pearson stands justly
 indebted to Samuel Campbell by seal note of one date
 with three presents for two hundred and twenty five
 dollars due & payable one day after date now this
 indenture witnesseth that the said William Pearson
 for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid
 and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the
 said William Pearson by the said Samuel Campbell in hand
 paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 have granted bargain sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Samuel Campbell all that certain piece parcel and
 tract of Land lying and being in Greenville County &
 State aforesaid in waters of Ready Fork of Ready River
 and containing one hundred and thirty seven acres more
 or less adjoining Lands of J. Parker Jernit George
 Edmund Combs & G. W. Curston Together with
 all and singular the right meadows and appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 to have and to hold well and singularly the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Samuel Campbell his heirs
 and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my heirs executors
 and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Campbell
 his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and
 against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or
 to claim the same or any part thereof Provided always
 nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the
 parties to these presents that if the said William Pearson
 his heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly
 pay or cause to be paid unto the said Samuel Campbell
 the sum of two hundred and twenty five Dollars and
 interest according to the note above mentioned then
 and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and
 void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof
 in any wise notwithstanding And it is covenanted
 and agreed upon by and between the parties to these
 presents that any default shall be made in payment
 of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the intent
 by the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the
 said William Pearson peaceably and quietly to hold in
 peace possession and enjoy all and singular the premises

above granted and released and every part thereof with the
 appurtenances and to have receive and take the rents issues
 and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof
 anything herein contained to the contrary hereof in
 any wise notwithstanding In witness whereof the

 justly indebted to the said John S. Woodside by seal note
 of one date with three presents for two hundred Dollars
 due the 20th day of December A.D. 1870 being in part of the
 purchase money for the tract of Land below described
 now this indenture witnesseth that the said William
 Pearson for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid
 and also in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to
 the said William Pearson by the said John S. Woodside
 in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents do grant bargain sold and released and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said John S. Woodside all that certain piece
 parcel and tract of Land containing sixty seven acres
 more or less lying in County and State aforesaid
 in waters of Ready Creek waters of Ready River adjoining
 Lands of Jacob Pore Robert Newton and others
 Beginning on a R. O. line N 28 E 19 Chain to
 Pine Run N 55 W 15 1/2 to a dogwood tree S 45
