To H. S. Gardner Secretary of State Sir In accordance with the provision of the act of the General Assembly of said State entitled an act to regulate the formation of corporations approved December 10th 1869 we beg leave to make the following certificate to wit that we stockholders of the Corporation known as the Sullivane Manufacturing Company Cotton Yarn and Calico Cloth Manufacturers organized June 1st 1870 and reorganized on the 28 September 1870 with with a capital stock of not less than twenty thousand dollars and doing business at Park Shoals on Reedy Fork creek waters of Reedy River in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid did on the 28 day of September 1870 at a meeting called for the purpose at which meeting forty fifth of the stock of the company was represented organized our company under the provisions of the act of the General Assembly above referred to and elected the officers required by said act Thirteen thousand four hundred and fifty one dollars of the capital stock of the company have actually been paid in and the par value of the shares has been fixed at one hundred dollars per share

Burn of Beaufort County in the State aforesaid in consideration of one thousand Dollars to me paid Edmund Wells of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Edmund Wells her that five acres and lot of Land there being and lying

in Greenville County and said State containing three and three quarters acres more or less and having the following lines miles and bounds to wit Beginning at a stone & o. no and running thence E 63 W 25° to a stone 70 m thence S 14 E 64 S 25° to a stone & run thence S 59 E 8 95° to a stone now stone No 1970 W 395° to the beginning corner adjoining lands of Elias Cantine on the East Moses Maxwell on the North and Rob. Burn on the west and South Together with all and singular the right members & appendages and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Edmund Wells his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edmund Wells his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming as to claim the same on any part therof witness my hand and seal this 13 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty and in the 95th year of the independence of the United States of America
