McCoy of the said State and County have granted bargain sold and released by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto J. P. McCoy a tract of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on both sides of Long Creek waters of Sandy River adjoining lands of J. Manning Cox, Lilly Clark and J. P. Martin and others containing one hundred and twenty two acres more or less beginning on a maple on a corner of the same runs N 84° 42' 00" to State 37 lines 138° 39' 6" to State 37 lines 236° 13' 50" to State in full three 347° 2' 19" 70" to State 37 lines 129° 2' 14" 50" to State 37 lines 165° 41' 25" to State on road 240° 03' 12" to State 478° 41' 45" 03' 12" to State 172° 14' to State 37 lines 178° 41' 22" to maple between creek & branch three branch line to the beginning together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments appertinances or appertaining to the above described land I bind myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the same unto J.
