Henry Forrester Heirs Know all men by these presents that I Isaac Forrester of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the love and affection I have for my son Henry Forrester of Greenville District and State aforesaid as well as one Dollar to me in hand paid by him have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Forrester a certain tract of parcel of land it bearing part of the tract when I now live situated in the District and State aforesaid on branch waters of Little Creek of Green River Beginning at a Chestnut st dead end and runs S 42 1/4 W 25 3/8 along a road to a Stake st thence S 77 1/4 W 14 5/8 to a Stake st thence S 3 W 12 5/8 to a Stone st thence S 73 1/2 E 38 1/10 to a Stone st thence N 4 1/2 E 37 3/30 to a Lightwood Stake st thence N 58 1/2 W 6 5/8 to the Beginning containing eighty seven acres more or less Together with all and singular the right members hereunto appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Forrester his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend the said Henry Forrester his heirs and assigns for ever against me and my heirs and assigns every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
