Echo Killgore Land Know all men by these presents that I Wilson Coors of Granville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and thirty Dollars to me paid by Echo Killgore of Granville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and release unto the said Echo Killgore all that tract or Lot of Land Commencing at a Post on Mulberry Street about one mile from the Court House and running thence along said Street N 55 E 3 1/4 Chains to Rock & thence S 35 E 3 1/4 to Rock & thence S 55 W 3 1/4 Chains to Rock & thence N 35 W 3 1/4 Chains to the Beginning Corner and Bounded by Lots of Henry Fulbright Robert Sims and Hans Prior containing one acre more or less and which is more fully represented by a plot annexed made by H. P. Johnson together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining I have and do hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Echo Killgore and his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Echo Killgore and his heirs and assigns against myself myself and my heirs and any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and Seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two and in the ninety fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of Wilson Coors
