and released and by these presents do Grant bargain
sell and release unto the said William H. McCarroll
all my undivided half in that piece parcel and
Tract of land situated lying and being in the
County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina
on the walls of Meadow Creek and must be
adjoining lands of Art. James John P. Murtin
and others containing two hundred
and eighty and one fourth acres more or less
and having such miles and bounds as is
represented by a plat of the same attached to the
 deed of Conveyance of said Tract from Oliver
Borrito to William P. King bearing date the
27th day of September in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty five
and known as the May Taylor Peace Deed
with all and singular the rights premises
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
in any wise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said William H. McCarroll his
heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my
self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and defend defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said William H. McCarroll his heirs and
assigns against me and my heirs and every other
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof Witness my hand
and seal this first day of January in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
three and in the ninth month year of the Independence
of the United States of America signed sealed
