Know all men by these presents that we James Henson and Elijah Henson of the State & County of aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred & fifty dollars to us in hand paid by James Odum of the same State and County the receipt and payment on hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed & by these presents doth bargain sell and convey a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in said State and County on wild cat branch of Hortonberry Creek within of Middle Sugar River unto the said James Odum his heirs and beginning on a Red Oak on Packer Mountain the corner of the Clayton grant thence nearly South with the line of the grant to the branch on Jasper Paces line thence down the branch as it meanders far enough by passing in a North direction to Swifts line to make fifty Acre then with Swifts line to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to the same or in any wise incident or appertaining to it we the said James Henson & Elijah Henson doth for ourselves and heirs Executors administrators assigns warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said James Odum his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against ourselves our heirs and assigns and against any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
