to me in hand paid by Ramsey Foster of Greenville
County and State before and further consideration
hereinafter specified have granted bargained sold
and released and by these presents do grant Bargain
sell and release unto the said Ramsey Foster all
that tract or parcel of land situate lying and
being in Greenville County and State aforesaid
on branch waters of South Tyger River it being
one half of the tract of land wherein Spartan
Goodlett late of Greenville County lived Beginning at
a stone 3x near the dry branch and runs thence N 28⁴⁵ E
E 53.24 to a stone in the Saluda Gap Road thence along
said Road S 71¹⁵ E 3.20 to a stone 37 thence N 31 W 17.90
to a Red oak 37 thence S 79⁴⁴ E 39.50 to a stone 37 thence
S 47 W 36.10 to a Red oak 37 and dead thence N 78⁴⁵ W 20.40
to a large white oak 37 and run down on branch
thence down said branch to a Hickory 37 thence N 84
W 30.24 to the Beginning containing two hundred
and thirty seven acres more or less the further
consideration for the covenants of the above
described tract of land on that the said Ramsey
Foster is bound to take his mother-in-law Mrs Frances
Goodlett unto his home and give her a comfortable
support of food and raiment to tract her kindly
