 and by these presents do grant Bought Sell Release
 unto the said Anthony Davis all that tract of Land
 lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
 upon a portion of Mountain Creek Branch of Saluda
 River containing Two Hundred and thirty five (235)
 acres more or less adjoining lands of Robert
 McCullough Jesse French John Cooley and others lying
 the same Tract of Land conveyed to the said James
 McCullough by and of B. B. Johnson and J. H. Ware
 Executors of the Estate of P. S. Johnson (deceased) Beginning
 at a white oak 3⁺ and running thence S 37^o W 21.50
 a white oak near the spring thence down the
 meanders of said Spring Branch to a dogwood 3⁺
 thence S 87^o W to a Red oak stump 3⁺ thence S 5^o
 E 7.00 to a Spanish oak 3⁺ (N. M.) thence S 87^o W 40.50
 to a white oak 3⁺ on Mountain Creek thence the
 meanders of said Creek to a Hickory 3⁺ (gone) thence
 N 4^o E 60.00 to a Poplar 3⁺ (down) thence S 85^o E 5.00
 to a Pine 3⁺ (gone) thence N 24^o W 90.00 to a Stake thence
 N 6^o E 27.30 to a stone 3⁺ thence S 83^o E 51.50 to the
 Beginning Together with all and singular the
 rights Members Hereditaments & Appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining thereto to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Anthony Davis and his heirs and assigns forever
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
 Administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said Anthony
 Davis His Heirs and assigns against me and
 and my heirs and every person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth (29)
 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight Hundred and thirty three (1873) and in the
 seventh (7) year of the Independence of the
