 anywise incident or appertaining. I have and
 do hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 subject to the aforesaid reservation unto the said Mary
 Moore for and during the term of her natural
 life or widowhood and after her death or marriage
 unto the said Martha Carolina Goddard wife of
 Lucius Goddard William Thomas Moore and Jefferson
 Davis Moore their heirs and assigns forever And I do
 herby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 said premises unto the said Mary Moore for and
 during the term of her natural life or widowhood
 and from and after her death or marriage unto
 the said Martha Carolina Goddard wife of Lucius
 Goddard William Thomas Moore & Jefferson Davis
 Moore their heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs and against every other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this fourth day
 of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and seventy three and in the twenty eighth
 year of the sovereignty & independence of the United
