 County and State aforesaid have granted bargain sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said John P. Smith all that tract or
 parcels of land containing 125 Acres more or less situated
 in Greenville County lying on both sides of Damocritus Road
 Beginning at a Spanish Oak near Pleasant Grove Church
 and runs N 85 E 44 Chains on Boundary line to a Post
 Oak and thence N 55 W 49 50 Chains on the A. H. Williams
 line to a State fence S 30 W 46 Chains on the H. Williams
 & Green line to a Spanish Oak thence S 60 E 26 Chains
 on W. P. Taylor line to the Beginning 313 Together with
 all and singular the rights appurtenances & appurtenances
 & appurtenances to the same premises hereunto or
 in anywise incident or appertaining to have and
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said John P. Smith his heirs and assigns
 forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and
 Administrators to warrant and defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said John P.
 Smith his heirs and assigns against myself and
 my heirs and against every other person or persons
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
