between J L Southern Esquire Sheriff of Greenville County  
South Carolina of the one part and P G Green of the other  
part witnesseth Whereby Emma W Westfield on on  
about the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our  
Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy three  
did exhibit his petition in the Court of Probate at Green-  
ville Court house in the County of Greenville and State  
aforesaid against Mary Westfield and John O West-  
field praying for a sale of the Real Estate of John  
Westfield dead for partition among the legal heirs  
and for the purpose of liquidating his indebtedness

aforesaid on branches of Mashy and Archland  
Creeks adjoining lands of Croft L G Green Tract No  
3 et al containing One hundred twenty and one  
half acres more or less as will more fully appear
