of Middle Tyger River bounded by lands of of L D McKimney Sarah  
Cowan Ann Cowan Dennis Cowan and Joseph McKimney Beginn  
ing at a Stake 3x in Middle Tyger River and runs S 8 E 25 to a  
Palmum 3x thence S 8 1/2 E 20 5/8 to a Red Oak 3x 3x thence N 30 1/2  
E 22 2/5 to a black Oak 3x 3x thence N 21 E 11 5/4 to a Stone 3x at or  
fence big to a Stake in the Middle of Middle Tyger River water gap  
thence down said River 100 chains to the mouth of a branch called
