do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said
J P Glenn all that tract or parcel of land in said State
and County aforesaid, abut one and one half miles East
of Greenville, along the Laurens Road beginning at Stone
corner on said Laurens road thence N 62° E 134.80 ds.
to stone & one chain (N 62° E 134.80 ds.) thence
S 60° W 47.50 ds. to stone 37 mds. thence along said Laurens
S 58 1/2 E 10.30 ds. to the Beginning corner containing
forty four acres more or less and bounded by
lands of Wm Gladding, Wm. A. Austin, Paul Land
said J P Glenn and Laurens road
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining,
In shape and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said J P Glenn his
heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby

division made according to the Will of Eliza Green
situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid
containing forty six acres be the same more or less, and
bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a Stake 31 mds.
on the Laurens Road Maddox and J P Gladdings corner
running thence N 57 1/2 E 33.80 chains to a stone 34 mds.
thence along Eliza's Paul land N 89 W 10.11 ds. to a stone
34 mds. thence S 62 W 42.80 chains to a Stake 31 mds.
the Laurens Road thence along the Laurens Road S 58 1/2
E 15.70 chains to the beginning corner, together with
