to Stone & one thence N 24 W 90 ch to R. C. 37 and thence  
S 62 W 175 ch to State 37 and thence along said Laurens  
S 5 1/2 E 10 30 ch to the Beginning corner containing  
41 1/2 forty one 1/2 Acres more or less and bounded by  
lands of Wm Goldsmith Thomas Paul land  
said J G Glenn and Laurens road

cut off from the same as the share of Mary J Glenn in a  
division made according to the will of Elisha Glenn Deced  
situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid  
containing forty six Acres be the same more or less and  
bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a State 37 1/2 on  
on the Laurens Road Maddox and R. J. Glammonds corner  
running thence N 57 1/4 E 32 80 chains to a Stone 37 1/2 nm  
thence along Thomas Paul land N 29 W 10 1/4 ch to a Stone

E 15 50 chains to the Beginning corner Together with
