Frazier of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, aliened and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Andrew Miller and William H. Frazier their heirs and assigns all that tract or plantation of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on Reedy River and West of the Buncomb Road three and one half miles from the City of Greenville bounded by lands of the Est of J. M. Young on the North the Buncomb Road on the East Long Leasureway here on South and Reedy River on the West and containing five hundred acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew Miller and William H. Frazier their heirs and assigns forever, And we do hereby bind our heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Andrew Miller and William H. Frazier their heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
