Roe of the County of Greenville all that certain parcel of land situate in the said County of Greenville and described as follows commencing at a cedar at the foot of the branch on the Road to Mostillers Mill thence a West course to a Rock corner on the road running from Leinaths Bridge to the Columbia Road thence along said Road to Henry D. Roe's land containing two acres more or less with all the appurtenances all the right title and interest claim and demand of us or either of us in the premises to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Henry D. Roe and his heirs in fee simple forever and I the said Ransom Foster and Francis J. Foster do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the same premises unto the said H. D. Roe his heirs and assigns against any Executors & my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
