Know all men by these presents that I W B Johnson of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J M Watson in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J M Watson all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville & State aforesaid adjoining lands of Marshall Shelton John Norris and others and containing One hundred & sixty five Acres more or less the same being the tract of land conveyed to the said W B Johnson by James P Morre & E L D Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J M Watson his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J M Watson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
